That's why I have two cameras, with two memory card slots, back up memory cards, extra batteries and chargers to mitigate any potential for lost files. And when I get home I back up your files to two different hard drives, and my online cloud storage until I have delivered your full wedding gallery.

MEET YOUR PHOTOGRAPHER!

This is absolutely, 100 percent something you should do BEFORE your wedding day. Whether via Zoom, or in person; meeting your photographer will really help you know if they're the right fit for you and your partner.

I make a habit of meeting all my couples before their wedding day, and highly encourage having an engagement session with me (in fact, I include this in my top wedding photography package!) so that on the day you both feel super chill and know when I rock up with my cameras that we're going to have a good time together! :-)

And hey, it's absolutely OK if we meet and you decide to go in another direction. Truth be told, I want to work with people that feel like we've "clicked" (yep, that was a photography pun, I just can't help myself!) and I know that if you're not comfortable then that will show in your photos, so really it's in my best interest to make sure that we get on.
